The Arts Center continues to fulfill the Jamestown Fine Arts Association mission statement: "Enrich the Jamestown area community through the arts."

**A YEAR IN BRIEF**

I'm not certain how each year could seem busier than the last – but that's certainly the case at The Arts Center. This annual report reflects the numerous performances, exhibits, special events and a list of artists who taught adults and students in the schools, after school, weekends and during the summer. As these artists taught in the classrooms, they gave teachers an opportunity to participate as "students" so that they could increase their abilities in arts instruction. Opportunities to expand skills and knowledge while utilizing the ARTS as problem solving tools are unique attributes of the many Arts Center activities throughout the year.

The most exciting part of this busy year was renovating the building adjacent to the Arts Center. Thanks to the generosity of Charlotte and Gordon Hansen, the new Hansen Arts Studio has provided a terrific space for ceramics and a much-needed classroom for adults. Each studio-classroom now has equipment for the stained glass, bookmaking, printmaking, jewelry and ceramic artists who use the space. The façade of the Hansen Arts Studio gives us an idea what the Arts Center's exterior will look like when its remodeling is complete. To date, half the funding designated for renovation of the current Arts Center has been secured. We anticipate the remaining funds will be in place in the spring so that the renovation can begin next summer.

The remodeled Arts Center will provide an improved space for the energized 2<sup>nd</sup> ACT (community theatre group – 2<sup>nd</sup> Street Arts Center Theatre). This group has staged two recent hits – *Plaza Suite* and *A Bad Year for Tomatoes*. We can hardly wait to see what future productions 2<sup>nd</sup> ACT intends to bring to our community.

As the Center grows in programming and facilities, so does the staff. Angela Martini joined the staff as administrative assistant to help the office be more organized and productive. All of this productivity, however, will not be possible without the continued support of many volunteers who assist in everything from serving on the board of directors to bringing food for a reception to helping set up and clean up after an event. Many thanks to all of you who help the Arts Center deliver quality programming in the arts as we "enrich the Jamestown area community through the ARTS."
