**September 10**      **Element:** Line      **Book:** *Mirette on the High Wire*

*Mirette on the High Wire:* Mirette learns to walk a tightrope from a mysterious guest at her mother's boarding house. The guest turns out to be the famous tightrope artist Monsieur Bellini, who quit performing because of his fear.

**October 8**      **Element:** Line      **Book:** *The Girl Who Loved Wild Horses*

*The Girl Who Loved Wild Horses:* A young Native American girl chooses to leave her people and live with the wild horses, where she finds true happiness.

**November 12**      **Element:** Shape      **Book:** *Tar Beach*

*Tar Beach:* A young girl living in a Harlem apartment with her parents and brother dreams of flying over the city at night. She imagines claiming everything she sees for herself and her family.

**December 10**      **Element:** Texture      **Book:** *Where the Wild Things Are*

*Where the Wild Things Are:* Sent to his room for misbehaving, a young boy imagines sailing away to an island of huge monsters who make him their king because they love him. He sails home to find the person who loves him best of all.
