PAINTING ANIMALS with Mr. Billy

Jan 9 – 20

(9 Days)

Fur, scales, beaks and feathers. This painting class will use acrylic paint in a step by step process to understand the best way to paint detailed and exciting paintings of your favorite animals. Each student will choose the animal they like best and then as a class we will go through the steps: sketch/composition, underpainting, color matching, editing, and final details.

CLAY WORKS with Mr. Billy

Stick your hands into a big pile of mushy clay and get dirty. This two week hand building class will challenge students to create a set of tiles, build a figurine, create a pinch pot, and maybe even try throwing a pot on the wheel. During the drying time the class participates in the Clay Games in which teams of students are challenged to build the tallest tower, make the most balls, build the longest bridge etc. The second week of class we fire the work and learn about glazing. Students will have a variety of colorful ceramic pieces by the end of this class.

Molly McLain

Molly McLain grew up in Valley City, ND and graduated from VCSU with a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Art in 2005. She finds herself reflecting on her connection with immediate surroundings and day to day happenings in her art. Molly draws inspiration for her art from a strong sense of connection to the prairie. She creates mixed media pieces about the evolution of agriculture.
